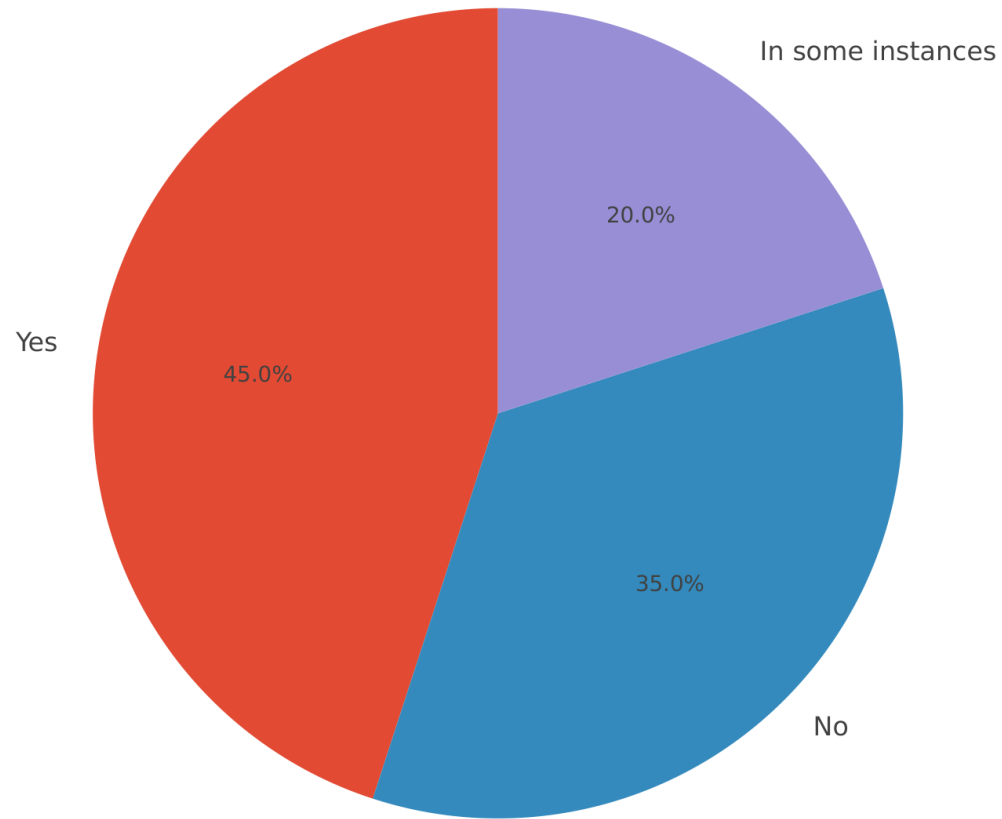

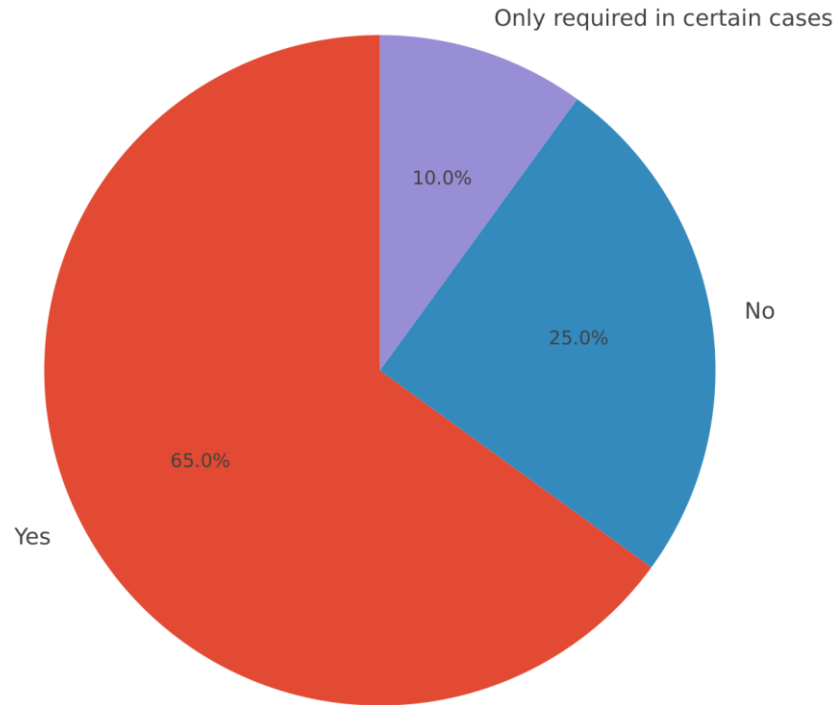


Case Intake vs Cases Decided per Year by State (Updated)

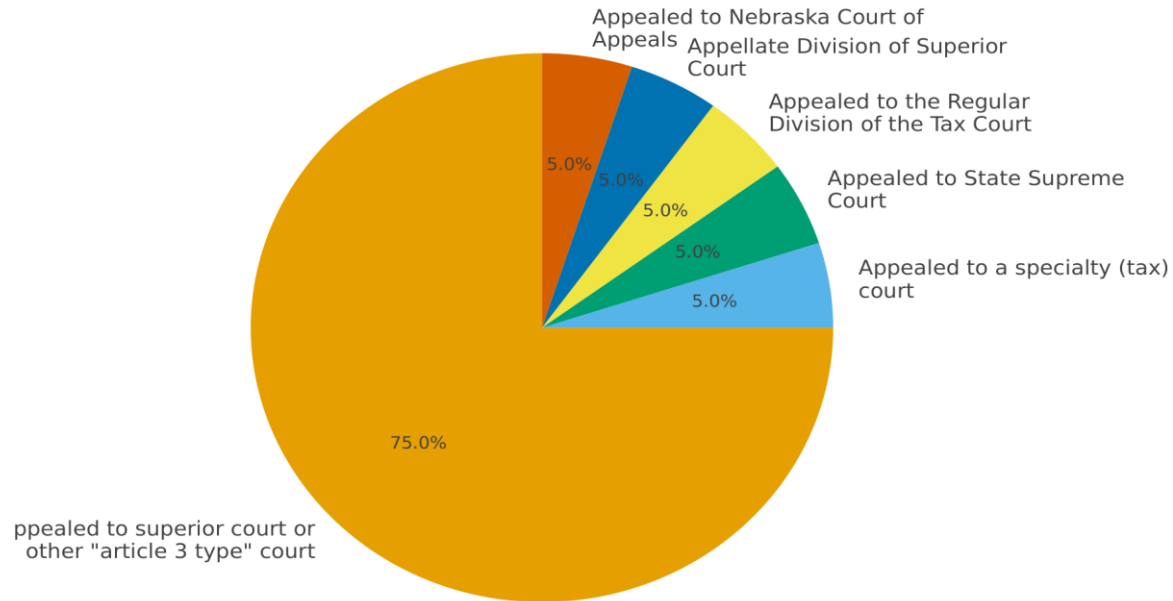


Publication of Opinions
